

Application for security export control

Foreigners or non-residents are required to submit this check sheet and the certificate of employment of your institution to use supercomputers. This check sheet is used to obtain an export control permission from the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) of Japan.

Here is the definition of non-residents.

Japanese	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Those who departed from Japan and stay outside Japan for the purpose of working at an overseas office2. Those who departed from Japan and stay outside Japan for the purpose of staying outside Japan for two years or longer3. Those who stay outside Japan after the departure from Japan for two years or longer4. Those who fall under any 1 through 3 and returned to Japan as a temporary homecoming staying for less than six months so far
Foreigners	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. All foreigners who do not work at an office in Japan, or who do not stay in Japan for six months or longer after entry2. Persons in public service governments or internal institutions3. Diplomats, consuls or accompanying personnel/servants thereof (only those appointed/hired outside Japan)
Corporations or legal persons	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Foreign corporations/legal persons except offices including a branch/sub-branch of an international corporation in Japan, Japan's international diplomatic offices, and Japanese corporations/legal persons2. Offices including a branch/sub-branch of a Japanese corporation in other countries3. Diplomatic offices of foreign governments and international institutions in Japan
